The Board of Commissioners of the Parrish Fire District met in regular session on Tuesday, October 24, 2023, at 6:00 P.M. in the Commission Chamber.

Chairman Chitty opened the meeting of the Parrish Fire Commission.

The minutes of the previous meeting held September 26, 2023, were approved on a motion by Commissioner Webb, seconded by Commissioner Griesi and carried by a vote of 5-0.

Chairman Chitty called for public comment, there was none.

Chief advised the board that we needed to have the first reading of the new Fire Prevention Ordinance # 5, that will be replacing Fire Prevention Ordinance #4. Commissioner Griesi made a motion to accept the first reading of Fire Prevention Ordinance # 5, seconded by Commissioner Hendry and carried by a vote of 5-0.

Chief Bailey advised that we need to establish a public hearing for the 2<sup>nd</sup> reading of the Fire Prevention Ordinance # 5. Commissioner Hendry made a motion to hold the public hearing on November 28, 2023, seconded by Commissioner Griesi and carried by a vote of 5-0.

Chief Bailey presented Resolution 2023-06, Budget Adjustments for Fiscal Year 2022/23, for the appropriation of funds to balance out categories that have overages. Resolution 2023-06 was approved on a motion by Commissioner Webb, seconded by Commissioner Griesi and carried by a vote of 5-0.

Chief Bailey advised the board that it was time to update the existing Statewide Mutual Aid Agreement, Commissioner Webb made a motion to approve Resolution 2023-07 Statewide Mutual Aid Agreement, seconded by Commissioner Griesi and carried by a vote of 5-0.

Chief Bailey advised the board that there were several items that needed to be deleted from the inventory, they are no longer in use, or broken. Commissioner Griesi made a motion to accept the deletions from inventory, seconded by Commissioner Stevens and carried by a vote of 5-0.

Chief Bailey advised the board that the District needed to adopt the new Fire Prevention Board of Appeals, there was a change to some of the board members. Commissioner Stevens made a motion to approve Resolution 2023-08 adopting the Fire Prevention Code Board of Appeals, seconded by Commissioner Hendry, and carried by a vote of 5-0.

Financial report for Year ending September 30, 2023, was presented. Chief Bailey indicated we had finished the year out with \$91,309.89 above the budgeted amount. The Impact Fee account is at \$727,147.20. The financial report was approved on a motion by Commissioner Webb, seconded by Commissioner Griesi and carried by a vote of 5-0.

In the Administration report Chief Bailey presented several items that are being worked on by staff, and the hiring of 3 new firefighters.
