April 25, 2023

The Board of Commissioners of the Parrish Fire District met in regular session on Tuesday, April 25, 2023, at 6:00 P.M. in the Commission Chamber.

Vice-Chairman Webb opened the meeting of the Parrish Fire Commission.

The minutes of the previous meeting held March 28, 2023, were approved on a motion by Commissioner Griesi, seconded by Commissioner Webb, and carried by a vote of 4-0.

Vice-Chairman Webb called for public comment. No one was present to speak.

Vice-Chairman Webb opened the public hearing for Fire Assessments Rates public hearing, no one from the public signed up to speak. A motion was made to close the public hearing by Commissioner Stevens, seconded by Commissioner Griesi, and carried by a vote of 4-0. Commissioner Stevens made a motion to approve Resolution 2023-01 with a 6.7% increase, seconded by Commissioner Chitty, and carried by a vote of 4-0.

The financial report for month ending March 2023 was presented. Chief Bailey indicated that we have received most of the general fund revenue, \$3,127,896.87 with \$36,238.55 left to collect. Impact fee revenue is currently at \$339,146.00 with \$135,854.00 still left to collect. The financial report was approved on a motion by Commissioner Griesi, seconded by Commissioner Webb and carried by a vote of 4-0.

In the administration report, Chief Bailey brought up many different items, and projects under way by Staff, & local events that everyone has covered. Commissioner Stevens asked Chief where we are at with the grant Chief advised at this time we are at 1 million coming to us, but it hasn't been finalized.

Commissioner Stevens – Great turnout for St. 2 Grand Opening, says people are already talking about St.3.

Commissioner Griesi – Thanked everyone for a job well done with St. 2 Grand Opening, it was a great turnout today.

Commissioner Webb – Agreed with everyone on a great turn out today for St. 2, job well done by all. **Chairman Chitty** – Job well done by everyone, wished I could have been there today for the Grand Opening, can't wait to see the Station. Asked Chief about putting the gate at the end of the dirt drive, Chief is still working on different options.
