Chairman's Report

#### September 24, 2024

The Board of Commissioners of the Parrish Fire District met in regular session on Tuesday, September 24, 2024, at 6:00 P.M. in the Commission Chamber.

Chairman Chitty opened the meeting of the Parrish Fire Commission.

The minutes of the previous meeting held August 27, 2024, were approved on a motion by Commissioner Webb, seconded by Commissioner Stevens and carried by a vote of 5-0.

Fire Chief

Chairman Chitty called for public comment, there was no one signed up to speak to the board.

Chairman Chitty opened the public hearing to hear tax appeals from property owners with respect to the method of calculation or the amount levied against a parcel of land within the district. 0 people signed up to speak. Commissioner Webb made a motion to close the public hearing, seconded by Commissioner Stevens and carried by a vote of 5-0.

Chief Bailey presented Resolution 2024-05; "Appeals Hearing" and was approved on a motion by Commissioner Griesi, seconded by Commissioner Ramsey and carried by a vote of 5-0.

Chief Bailey presented the proposed budget for Fiscal year 2024-25, after some discussion on the budget Commissioner Ramsey made a motion to approve the proposed budget for 2024-25, seconded by Commissioner Griesi and carried a vote of 5-0.

Chief Bailey recommended to the board to approve Resolution 2024-04 which approves the 2024-25 Fiscal Budget, Commissioner Stevens made a motion to approve Resolution 2024-04, seconded by Commissioner Griesi and carried by a vote of 5-0.

Chief Bailey presented the financial report for month ending August 31, 2024. Chief Bailey indicated we collected everything, you will see it shows that we are still \$34,869.33 left to collect, that was a mess up on the tax roll, a property was charged \$33,967.00 in error by the county, it should have been \$339.67 and the mortgage company already paid the bill, so the Parrish Fire District had to reimburse the homeowner back. Impact Fee we have collected \$722,961.00 as of this fiscal year. Commissioner Stevens made a motion to approve the Financial Report for August 31, 2024, seconded by Commissioner Griesi and carried by a vote of 5-0.

In the administration report, Chief Bailey had several items he went over. Due to Hurricane Helene threatening the state of Florida, Chief Bailey advised the board it would a good thing to go ahead and declare state of emergency for the Fire District. Commissioner Webb made a motion to approve Resolution 2024-06, seconded by Commissioner Stevens and carried by a vote of 5-0.

Chairman Chitty called for Commissioners comments -

**Commissioner Ramsey** – Good job firefighters on the fire

Commissioner Stevens – Satisfied with everything going on, still has an issue with the new numbers on the trucks. I would like to see the numbers changed back to the 1400's. Commissioner Webb made a motion to change the numbers back to the 1400's, Commissioner Stevens seconded the motion. After much discussion, Commissioner Stevens retracted his second and tabled the motion to next month's meeting. Chairman Chitty advised the Chief he was to have a letter from the Radio shop telling the board when the switch over date would be for the radio channel

Commissioner Griesi - Nothing to say.

Commissioner Webb — I've got several things I'd like to discuss. Wants to talk about the employee under investigation, Chairman Chitty says I don't think we can discuss that right, cause it's an active investigation. I did an informal discussion with everybody and came up with stuff that makes me sick. But if you guys could go out, and talk to everybody, that would be the best thing, and you'll know for yourself. Commissioner Webb made a motion to place Chief Bailey on Administrative leave pending the outcome of the Investigation, no one seconded the motion, the motion dies. Commissioner Griesi, Commissioner Stevens, and Commissioner Ramsey asked what email Commissioner Webb was referring to, as none of them have seen it. They would like time to see this email and talk to the employees themselves. Chief Bailey recommends getting legal counsel involved so everyone is protected legally, Chairman Chitty agrees, Chief Bailey said he will get with legal staff and get everything set up. Commissioner Ramsey made a motion to have a special meeting on October 2, 2024 @ 9:00am. Seconded by Commissioner Webb and carried by a vote of 5-0. Commissioner Ramsey said we need to walk very carefully on this matter. Chairman Chitty — Thanked the firefighters for a great job at the fire.
