The Board of Commissioners of the Parrish Fire District met in regular session on Tuesday, April 27, 2021, at 7:00 P.M. in the Commission Chamber.

Chairman Chitty opened the meeting of the Parrish Fire Commission.

The minutes of the previous meeting held March 23, 2021 were approved on a motion by Commissioner Combee, seconded by Commissioner Griesi, and carried by a vote of 5-0.

Chairman Chitty called for public comment. No one was present to speak.

Chairman Chitty opened the public hearing for Fire Assessments Rates public hearing, no one from the public signed up to speak. A motion was made to close the public hearing by Commissioner Combee, seconded by Commissioner Griesi, and carried by a vote of 5-0. Commissioner Combee made a motion to approve Resolution 2021-01, seconded by Commissioner Webb, and carried by a vote of 5-0.

Chief Bailey presented the Engagement letter for Bond services for setting the perimeters for financing on Station 2 loan with Bryant, Miller, & Olive. Chief explained how we need to have a bond attorney for the financing of the loan. A motion was made to except the letter of engagement from Bryant, Miller, & Olive by Commissioner Webb, seconded by Commissioner Griesi and carried by a vote of 5-0.

The financial report for month ending March 2021 was presented. Chief Bailey indicated that we have received the majority of general fund revenue with the exception of \$105,159.27. Impact fee revenue is currently at \$268,223.80 with \$68,223.80 over what was budgeted. The financial report was approved on a motion by Commissioner Combee, seconded by Commissioner Griesi and carried by a vote of 5-0.

In the administration report, Chief Bailey brought up many different items working on the Cares ACT to get reimbursed for COVID related expenses, working on funding for Station 2, Leticia is working with Chris Roe on making sure everything is in place and on target for the \$80 for Fire Assessment, meet with the Lindsey's/L3 Farm for possibly station 4 site.
