The Board of Commissioners of the Parrish Fire District met in regular session on Tuesday, October 25, 2022, at 6:00 P.M. in the Commission Chamber.

Chairman Chitty opened the meeting of the Parrish Fire Commission.

The minutes of the previous meetings held September 7, 2022, were approved on a motion by Commissioner Webb, seconded by Commissioner Griesi and carried by a vote of 3-0.

The minutes of the Emergency meeting for Hurricane Ian was held September 26, 2022, were approved on a motion by Commissioner Webb, seconded by Commissioner Griesi and carried by a vote of 3-0.

Chairman Chitty called for public comment, there was none.

Chief Bailey asked to have a Commissioner be appointed as the new Secretary / Treasurer, due to Commissioner Combee no longer in the state. We need someone here that can be to sign documents if needed. Commissioner Webb made a motion to appoint Commissioner Griesi as Secretary / Treasurer, seconded by Commissioner Griesi and carried by a vote of 3-0.

Chief Bailey asked the board to allow him and his staff to start the application process for the opening of Seat 3 on the Board of Commissioners. Chief Bailey asked if we could advertise to receive applications to fulfill the position. And applications to be reviewed by the board at the November 22nd, 2022, meeting. Commissioner Griesi made a motion to start the application process, seconded by Commissioner Webb and carried by a vote of 3-0.

Chief Bailey presented Resolution 2022-06, Budget Adjustments for Fiscal Year 2021/22, for the appropriation of funds to balance out categories that have overages. Resolution 2022-06 was approved on a motion by Commissioner Webb, seconded by Commissioner Griesi and carried by a vote of 3-0.

Financial report for Year ending September 30, 2022, was presented. Chief Bailey indicated we had finished the year out with \$234,585.27 above the budgeted amount. The Impact Fee account as of September 30, 2022, is at \$809,166.98. The financial report was approved on a motion by Commissioner Griesi, seconded by Commissioner Webb and carried by a vote of 3-0.

In the Administration report Chief Bailey presented several items that are being worked on by staff. Also spoke about the update on Station 2. And other events that are coming up.
