January 28, 2020

The Board of Commissioners of the Parrish Fire District met in regular session on Tuesday, January 28. 2020, at 7:00 P.M. in the Commission Chamber.

Vice-Chairman Webb opened the meeting of the Parrish Fire Commission.

The minutes of the previous meeting held November 26, 2019 were approved on a motion by Commissioner Combee, seconded by Commissioner Trompke and carried by a vote of 4-0.

Vice-Chairman Webb called for public comment, there was none.

Chief Bailey asked about going out for an RFQ for Architectural services that will also define the process for advertisements, Dates, forms, scoring & selection process for station 2. Chief Bailey advised the board that the short list committee would consists of Chief Bailey, Leticia Teague & a Commissioner. Chief Bailey asked for the Commissioner that was going to be on the short list to have some knowledge of construction. Chief asked that he would like to see Commissioner Trompke on the short list. It was decided that Commissioner Trompke would be the representative from the board. Commissioner Dirling made a motion to approve going out for RFQ as long as the changes were reflected in the RFQ, seconded by Commissioner Trompke and carried by a vote of 4-0.

Chief Bailey talked about the Station 2 Construction Loan and asked if administration could at least meet with some vendors about loans. USDA loan we know it will be a 2% interest on the loan and can be paid back in 40 years. Commissioner Trompke made a motion to allow the administration to start talking more in detail with at least 3 different banks, seconded by Commissioner Dirling and carried by a vote of 4-0.

Chief Bailey presented Resolution 2019-01 - to amend the budget for the sum of \$20,000.00 to be deducted from the Unrestricted General Fund and added to budget category Legal/Professional services. Commissioner Combee made a motion to Approve Resolution 2019-01, seconded by Commissioner Dirling and carried by a vote of 4-0.

Financial reports for month ending November 30, 2019 and month ending December 31, 2019 were presented. Chief Bailey indicated that the general fund had received \$1,044,101.11 in revenue while expenditures have been minimal. The Impact Fee account has received \$66,500.00 for the year. The financial reports were approved on a motion by Commissioner Combee, seconded by Commissioner Dirling and carried by a vote of 4-0.

In the administration report, Chief Bailey discussed several items that have come up.
With no further business for the board, Commissioner Combee motioned to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Commissioner Dirling and carried by a vote of 4-0. Meeting adjourned at 7:50 P.M.
